**Paul Bernard** introduced our speaker this morning, <u>Jim Kroll</u>. Jim is a Manager associated with the Denver Public Library Conservation Association, Colorado Historic Society, and Denver Public Library Western History Genealogy Department. He gave an interesting overview of many Colorado History facts and asked questions that tested and stumped our members. Jim also made available copies of "*The Forgotten Dreamer*," a beautifully designed and presented booklet on Reinhard Schuetze, Denver's Landscape Architect. Thanks for you memorable talk!

For those interested, Jim tells the story of the origins of the DPL's photo digitization project, one of the early large-scale digitization projects and an inspiration for the Colorado Digitization Project. The Denver Public Library's Photodigitization Project started in 1994 with the help of several grant funders including the U.S. Commerce Department's Telecommunications and Information Infrastructure Assistance Program (TIIAP), the Boettcher Foundation, the National Endowment for the Humanities Preservation and Access Program, the Colorado Historical Society's State Historical Fund and a private donation. The project was a result of the vision of Augie Mastrogiuseppe, who in 1990.
